

YOU COULD BE ELIGIBLE FOR A FREE NHS FLU VACCINATION

Those who are eligible to get a free NHS flu vaccination in 2025/26 include:

- People aged 65 years and over
- Individuals aged 6 months to under
 65 years in clinical risk groups
- People who are pregnant
- All children aged 2 and 3 years on 31 August 2025
- School-aged children (Reception to Year 11), even if not in school

- Residents of long-stay residential care homes
- Carers in receipt of carer's allowance, or the main carer of an elderly or disabled person
- Close contacts of immunocompromised individuals
- Frontline workers in social care settings without an employer-led occupational health scheme

Speak to a member of staff today to see if you are eligible for a free NHS flu vaccination.
