YOU COULD BE ELIGIBLE FOR A FREE NHS FLU VACCINATION

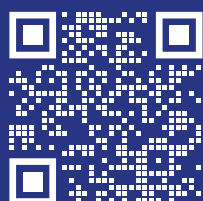
Those who are eligible to get a free NHS flu vaccination in 2025/26 include:

- People aged **65 years and over**
- Individuals aged **6 months to under 65 years** in **clinical risk groups**
- People who are **pregnant**
- All children **aged 2 and 3 years** on 31 August 2025
- **School-aged children** (Reception to Year 11), even if not in school
- Residents of long-stay **residential care homes**
- **Carers** in receipt of **carer's allowance**, or the **main carer** of an elderly or disabled person
- Close **contacts of immunocompromised** individuals
- **Frontline workers** in social care settings without an employer-led occupational health scheme

Speak to a member of staff today to see if you are eligible for a free NHS flu vaccination.

If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist, or nurse.
